Student Council

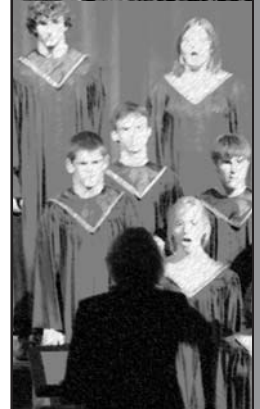
Students are elected to positions in the previous spring. The group meets on Wednesdays during community time. Advisor: Heather Anderson
